Stone Brook is a mature community so the placement of the mailbox should remain consistent with the prior installation.







# Placement Installation Requirements Mailbox Post



- There must be 41 to 45 inches of height from the street up to the bottom of your mailbox door. Average in Stone Brook is 38 to 42 inches
- Your mailbox door must be 6 to 8 inches from the curb when closed.
- Average distance from the front of the post to the curb is about 28 inches.
- Post should be no deeper than 24" below the surface. Concrete is optional and not recommended.
- **BEST ADVICE - Stone Brook is an established community so the best advice is to use the existing post location for a new post. It is NOT recommended that you change the location of your post.**
